Qualifications:

- ♦ Must be a Christian and able to articulate his testimony
- ♦ Meets the biblical qualifications of Pastor/Elder (1 Timothy 3:1–7; Titus 1:5–9; 1 Peter 5:1–4).
- ♦ Demonstrates spiritual and personal maturity/integrity.
- ♦ Strong burden to reach the lost and to integrate students into church ministries.
- ♦ Ability to identify, raise up, and train leaders.
- ♦ Effective Bible teacher and communicator.
- ♦ Good people skills and pastoral manner.
- ♦ Must be a person of prayer and personal devotion to Christ.
- ♦ If married, married to a like-minded wife and has a commitment to family.
- ♦ Agreement with Oakley doctrinal statement, vision, and philosophy of ministry.
- ♦ Must be in full agreement with the Baptist Faith and Message (2000) of the Southern Baptist Convention.
- ♦ Ministry experience preferred (but not required).
- ♦ Seminary and/or Bible College education is a plus (but not required).

General Responsibility:

- ♦ 20 hours per week—including, but not limited to, Sunday evening youth discipleship (5:45–6:45 PM) and Wednesday evening Bible study (only on 2nd and 4th Wednesdays)
- ♦ Building of an effective reaching and discipling ministry to middle school and high school students.
- ♦ Use effective In-Reach and Out-Reach Strategies to reach the youth of Chatham County and build the body of Christ.
- ♦ Teaching Strategies will include large group classes/gatherings, small groups, retreat-type events, and one-on-one mentoring to students.
- ♦ Engage students in personal & corporate prayer times.
- ♦ Develop annual calendar of activities and goals / objectives for the Student Ministry that, in turn, establish the annual budget submission for the Student Ministry. Understand and comply with the Student Ministry approved budget.
- ♦ Work closely with Youth Council.

Other Specific Responsibilities (not specifically Student Ministry related):

- ♦ Attend weekly staff meetings and other church gatherings / functions.
- ♦ Ensure good stewardship with all church resources.
- ♦ Strive to maintain unity and a holistic ministry approach in conjunction the pastor and overall church goals.
